## **Golden Gate Bridge 75th Anniversary Celebration**

**Who:** The Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District and the Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy—in cooperation with the National Park Service, the Presidio Trust, and the City and County of San Francisco—are honored to present the 75th Anniversary celebration of the Golden Gate Bridge.

**What:** Please visit goldengatebridge75.org for a schedule of events for the Golden Gate Festival on May 27, and a calendar of commemorative programs held by our community partners throughout the year. The May 27 celebration will allow thousands of visitors to enjoy history and educational presentations, a display of cars from 1937 to the present, an historic watercraft parade, music and dance stages, art installations, Bridge construction films, and displays by corporate and media partners.

**When:** Sunday, May 27, 2012. Recalling the historic "Golden Gate Bridge Fiesta" in 1937, this special event will tell the story of the Bridge and provide an opportunity for the entire community to celebrate together. At about 9:30 pm on May 27, the celebration will conclude with a spectacular 75th anniversary fireworks display and grand finale.



Where: The Golden Gate Festival will be a spectacular public event spanning the waterfront from Fort Point to Pier 39. Major program venues include Crissy Field and the Marina Green. Additional activities and events will be held at the Presidio, Fort Mason Center, Ghirardelli Square, San Francisco Maritime National Historical Park, Fisherman's Wharf, and Pier 39. While the Bridge will be open to auto traffic only and there will be no Bridge walk, there will be numerous vantage points and ways for the public to share in the Festival experience. Logistical planning is currently under development and all visitors will be encouraged to take public transit, walk, or bike to the Golden Gate Festival. Bike racks will be available and you may visit www.511.org for transit directions.
